

Northern Navajo Medical Center

The Northern Navajo Medical Center in Shiprock, New Mexico is located in the Four Corners area of the United States where New Mexico, Arizona, Colorado and Utah meet. The Shiprock Service Unit is the largest Service Unit serving The Navajo Nation and the facility has 55 beds



Approximately 45,500 Native Americans mostly Navajo Tribally enrolled live in the Service Unit. The daily Inpatient Load is 40, and the daily outpatient volume averages 400 a day. Annual OB Cases: number 600 and annual ER Cases: averages 15,000-16,000. Multiple field clinics open from 1-5 days per week, each are staffed by Shiprock MD's, NP's, PA's and CNM's.

The OB Department consists of 6 OB/GYN's and 6 CNM's. The CNM Department is a full scope practice that provides prenatal, intra-partum, post-partum, family planning, colposcopy, limited ultrasound services and well woman care. We also work closely with our PA and NP from Women's Health and with our satellite clinics in promoting health care to women throughout their reproductive life cycle.
